Air Transportation

Washington, DC has three major airports that service the area: Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA), Dulles International Airport (IAD), and Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport (BWI). For additional information visit <http://mwaa.com/>

Ground Transportation

Ronald Regan/Washington National Airport (DCA) is approximately 5 miles from downtown Washington, DC. There are several methods of ground transportation available from DCA to the conference hotel.

- Taxi fare is about \$25 each way
- Super Shuttle - Ask for COG Discount: Save \$2 off one way and \$5 off roundtrip. For more information call 1-800-BLUE VAN (258-3826) or go to: www.SuperShuttle.com Mention Group Code: RQ82M
- Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority's Blue and Yellow Metro rail lines stop adjacent to DCA terminals B and C. Fares to downtown Washington begin at \$1.35 and increase based on the time of day (rush hour) and distance traveled.

Dulles International Airport (IAD) is approximately 26 miles from downtown Washington, DC. There are several options for ground transportation from Dulles to the conference hotel.

- Washington Flyer Taxicabs service Dulles International Airport exclusively at the exit of the terminal and cost about \$55 one way.
- Super Shuttle - Ask for COG Discount: Save \$2 off one way and \$5 off roundtrip. For more information call 1-800-BLUE VAN (258-3826) or go to: www.SuperShuttle.com Mention Group Code: RQ82M

Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport (BWI) is approximately 30 miles from downtown Washington, DC.

- Taxis are located just outside of the baggage claim area of the lower level of the terminal and cost approximately \$70 one-way to DC.

- Amtrak trains (including the high-speed Acela) run between BWI and Union Station in DC. Check: www.amtrak.com for schedule, fare and reservation information. Non-Acela trains cost about \$12 one way and take approximately 30 minutes each way.
