

Membership Qualifications To the General Assembly

According to Article VII: Membership of the National Association of the Church of God's Bylaws.

The members of this assembly shall consist of:

1. Any ordained minister, unordained or licensed minister registered with the Assembly who meets one or more of the following requirements:

a. Is registered in the Annual Yearbook of the Church of God

(Anderson, Indiana).

b. Is a member in good standing in his/ her local congregation and state Ministerial Assembly/District.

c. Is currently pastoring a recognized congregation of the Church of God (Anderson, Indiana).

d. Is recognized by a State Assembly of the Church of God, Anderson, Indiana.

2. Two (2) laypersons per congregation in good standing shall be appointed by the local pastor. These persons shall meet one or more of the following requirements:

a. Is a layperson of the Church of God (Anderson, Indiana).

b. Is a lay representative appointed or elected by one of the boards, committees, commissions, the General Assembly, and Board of Directors regarding the term of office: No one appointed as a lay person can serve more than three (3) two (2) year terms. Each lay appointee shall register with the National Association of the Church of God (West Middlesex, Pennsylvania).
